## THE THEATREWORKS – A FESTIVAL FOR THE FUTURE

In August, 1970, an original musical called *Popcorn* electrified the Peninsula with its infectious energy and exuberant demand that theater be alive and exciting. Within months a second original production, *Intrusions*, won national acclaim from the American Community Theater Association and established a new company called Youth Workshop as an innovator of joyous and unique theatre.

Since then The Workshop, sponsored by The City of Palo Alto, has built a reputation with critics and audiences alike for imaginative, music-filled productions performed indoors and out throughout the area. We discovered that theater can happen anywhere – in restaurants and parks, libraries or even parking lots. Our repertoire grew to include contemporary plays and musicals along with unusual versions of theater classics by masters such as Shakespeare, Rostand and Moliere. And landmark productions such as *Cabaret* in Palo Alto's Old Police and Fire Station and the original 1930's musical *The Country Wife* at the Palo Alto Community Theatre added more and more theatergoers to the list of Workshop friends.

Now, after five acclaimed years, The Workshop is presenting its new summer season as The TheatreWorks-Festival '75. More than a change in name, The TheatreWorks is a new concept, an independent company with a goal – an ongoing Peninsula festival of summer entertainment at its best. We believe our festival of innovative theater can find a permanent home on the Peninsula and continue to build a strong regional reputation. Already many of our talented performers, designers and directors are returning every summer from all parts of the country. We hope you will return too, and join us for The TheatreWorks-Festival '75.
